- 1. A cover page which includes:
 - a. Name of course, author and instructor's name with title

- 2. Separate page & heading for each new section, capitalized at top center of that page SUMMARY, PRECIS, PAPER

Once this file is installed on your PC, you simply Print the file and select CutePDF Writer as the "printer". You will be asked to name the file and select the location for the file. CutePDF Writer often precedes the file name with the name of the source software (i.e. Microsoft Word).

Textbooks Living in the Balance of Grace and Faith Paperback – by Andrew Wommack

Grace and Faith are often seen as opposing forces. Many of those who emphasize God's grace believe once we are saved, His blessings, (peace, healing, prosperity) are then distributed sovereignly as He wills. Many of those who emphasize faith believe that what we receive from God is up to us; our willingness to study the Word, pray and fast, attend church, and even pay our tithe all determine God's blessings in our lives.

The real truth lies somewhere in between. Grace and faith are both essential ingredients in our walk with the Lord. However, emphasize either to the exclusion of the other and the imbalance will make it difficult to receive from God. This lack of understanding has led to much confusion, frustration, and disappointment in the Body of Christ.

Pagan Christianity?: Exploring the Roots of Our Church Practices Paperback – by Frank Viola

Have you ever wondered why we Christians do what we do for church every Sunday morning? Why do we "dress up" for church? Why does the pastor preach a sermon each week? Why do we have pews, steeples, and choirs? This ground-breaking book, now in affordable softcover, makes an unsettling proposal: most of what Christians do in present-day churches is rooted, not in the New Testament, but in pagan culture and rituals developed long after the death of the apostles. Coauthors Frank Viola and George Barna support their thesis with compelling historical evidence and extensive footnotes that document the origins of modern Christian church practices. Reimagining Church: Pursuing the Dream of Organic Christianity Paperback – by Frank Viola

Author Frank Viola gives readers language for all they knew was missing in their modern church experience. He believes that many of today's congregations have shifted from God's original intent for the church. As a prominent leader of the house church movement, Frank is at the forefront of a revolution sweeping through the body of Christ. A change that is challenging the spiritual status quo and redefining the very nature of church. A movement inspired by the divine design for authenticity community. A fresh concept rooted in ancient history and in God Himself.

*In this course there are some aspects of the books (and possibly videos) that CTS (and you) may not completely agree with ideologically. Part of this class is to review the differences in opinion and formulate your own views conceptually clarifying what to take with you into your strategic vision of personal ministry and what to leave behind. This should come out clearly in your writing.



Class Summary

The purpose of this class is to learn how to effectively live in harmony or balance. By this point in your educational journey, and life experience, you have likely become glaringly aware of the lopsided positions on "church", scripture, doctrines, theology and philosophy that have taken many good people off-course or possible even destroyed their lives, ministries and families. There is likely no person who has ever been seduced into a "cult" who woke up that morning with a desire to get into error and apostasy... No... it was a gradual process that required biblical concepts to be taken to unbalanced extremes.

There is a heavenly designed highway that our Good Father has prepared for all of humanity to travel. The problem is there are "ditches" on both sides of that roadway. The tension and pull towards one ditch of revelation or the other will be a gravitational constant throughout the rest of your ministry and life. Those that are successful over a lifetime have discovered this necessary truth and exercise it regularly. Far too often we find that when a minister gets into error, they tend to overcorrect their ministry vehicle and inadvertently wind up in the other ditch. The ditch on either side of the road will damage and eventually destroy the vehicle... which is why our adversary wants us unbalanced, disharmonized or out of sync. One glaring example is too much faith will make one a legalist in works of the flesh, but too much grace will make one embrace adopting unholiness and an attitude of lethargic emotional brokenness.

In this class we will also be looking at a better more biblically balanced view of "church." You will glean from servant shepherds who have been in the trenches of ministry for years, church planting, building disciples, and encouraging people to better live for King Jesus in His Kingdom. As Frank Viola puts it so well, our "purpose is to steal your heart for the Lord Jesus Christ and blow your mind to the heavenlies, bringing you into those intangible things of Christ and the deeper things of God." We believe that you are an intricate part in building a better, and more harmonized, expression of what our Lord Jesus had in His heart when He declared that the gates of Hades will NOT prevail against His ekklesia.
